Final project presentation

- Each team has approx. 1 hour (including questions)
- The presentation must include the following parts:
 - A demo of the program
 - A presentation of the system design
 - A presentation of the testing conducted so far
 - Individual presentations from each team member



Program demo

- Show typical scenarios of running the system
- Demonstrate all features of your program including error handling
- Prepare appropriate inputs that will showcase the different features of your program
- You have to clearly show the input without unnecessary delays
 - No searching of the filesystem
 - No scrolling around



Design presentation

- Must include some class diagrams showing the important classes in the system
- The diagrams **must** include relationships
- Show only important methods (if any)
- Objective: The audience knows which classes/methods perform important tasks in the system after the presentation is over



Testing presentation

- Objective: Convince the audience you have tested will all possible meaningful inputs
- Must include running test cases in Eclipse
- Coverage must be demonstrated



Individual presentations

- Each team member must spend at least 5 minutes describing their contribution to the project
- This may include:
 - Showcase a part of the code that you developed and are particularly proud of
 - Describe test cases you created
 - Present documentation that you created



Pro tip

- Practice your presentation multiple times so you know that:
 - It flows well
 - It is not too short
 - It is not too long
- Practice your presentation in front of your teammates
 - Use their feedback to improve your presentation
